Axis Network Audio: Essentials is a comprehensive foundation course on network audio. Students will learn how to install, configure, and operate network audio devices in standalone mode as well as in conjunction with network cameras. At the conclusion of the training, students will take the test for Audio Essentials certificate of completion to test their skills and prove their knowledge.

- > Coordinating devices, such as having a speaker play an announcement based on a camera event
- > Scheduling music or announcements
- > Utilizing audio analytics to cue audio or video events
- > Assessing space layout and acoustics to plan an appropriate network audio solution
- > Describing the science behind sound, such as sound pressure, decibels, pitch, sampling frequency and bit depth
