Cover your every access control need

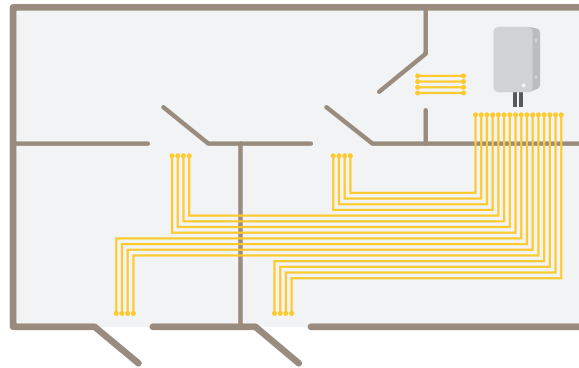

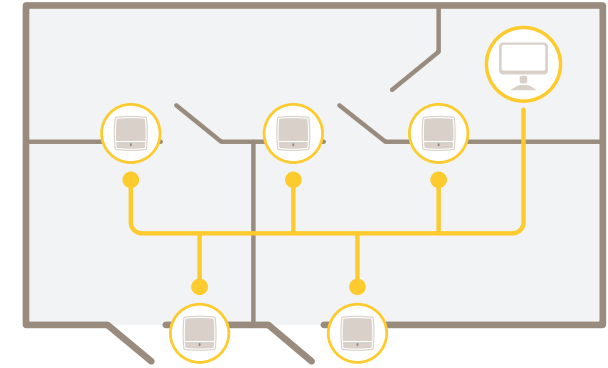
A complete solution with edge-based simplicity

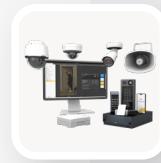

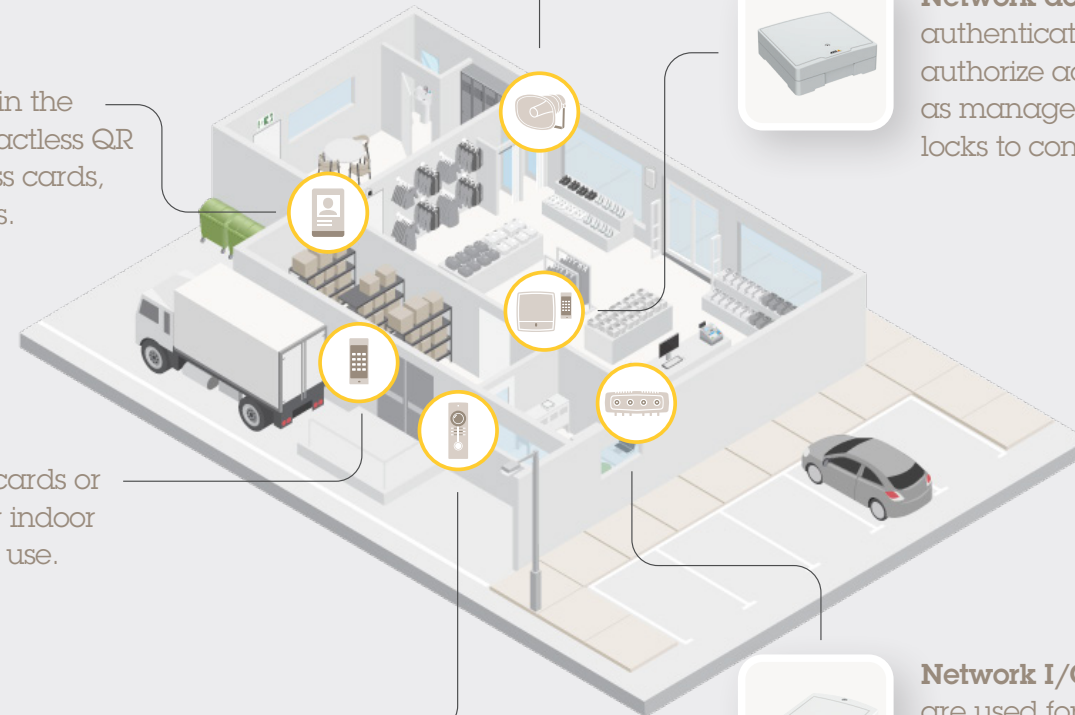

Seamless access with our QR code reader

Meet the needs of a mobile-first society with QR code access using AXIS Barcode Reader. It's a scalable, easy-to-install edge-based application that turns selected Axis intercoms and cameras into a QR code reader. The solution provides seamless access without the cost, complications, or waste of purchasing, managing, and disposing of physical cards. With digital credentials replacing plastic cards, you can reduce your environmental footprint.

The Axis Barcode Reader grants access to visitors easily. It begins by having the function installed on an Axis intercom or camera. Once you know when your visitor is coming, you create a QR code for them with a validity date and time. An email with the QR code is sent to your visitor, who can store it on their mobile device or print it. When the visitor arrives, they present the door code to the Axis intercom and camera, where optimized image quality combines with smart analytics and edge-based processing to recognize the credential. Relevant data is then sent to an Axis door controller, granting access.
