Axis headquarters is located on the outer edge in the northeast of the city and borders the university. One of the Axis configuration and logistic centers is located in the southwestern part of the city.

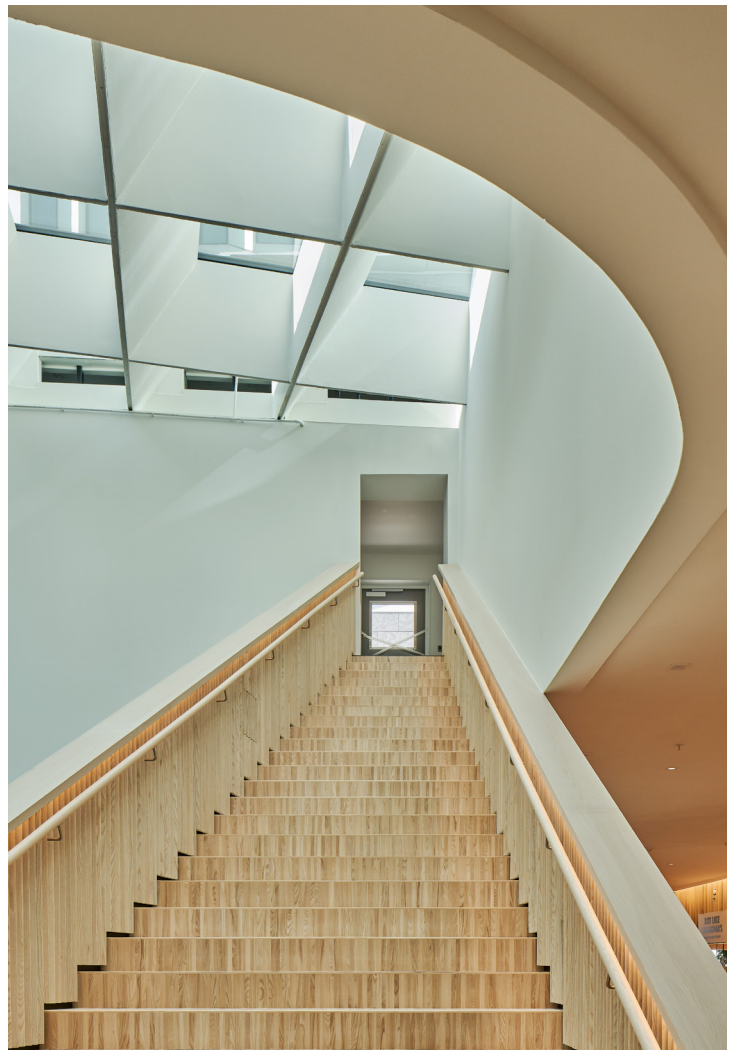

The official currency in Sweden is the Swedish Krona (SEK). Cash machines are commonly available, and credit cards are accepted at most vendors, including shops, restaurants, taxis, and parking garages.

Directions

By air

Copenhagen Airport (CPH)

The closest international airport is Copenhagen Airport (CPH), situated in Copenhagen, Denmark. With a 45-minute drive to our office, CPH offers direct flights to most global destinations. For more information, visit their website: www.cph.dk/en

From Copenhagen Airport, we suggest taking the Öresundståg train to Malmö or Lund, followed by a taxi or public transport ride to our office.

Alternatively, you can pre-book a car with our preferred taxi partner, Taxi Malmö, for door-to-door service. The estimated cost is approximately 1100 SEK one way. Please note that you may need to pass through passport control when crossing the Danish-Swedish border.

Malmö Airport (MMX)

If you're flying into Malmö Airport (MMX), this airport has great domestic connections to Stockholm and a few international routes. Use the airport shuttles that run frequently between Malmö Airport and Malmö Central station or prebook a taxi from Taxi Malmö for around 450 SEK one way.

By train/public transport

For easy travel on local public transportation in the region, download the Skånetrafiken app on your mobile phone. This will allow you to purchase tickets and access useful traffic information.

Axis Headquarters is about 8-10 minutes from Lund Central Station by taxi, local bus, or tram. To get here, take the local bus to "Lund Ideon Gateway" or the tram to "Lund Ideontorget", which is a short walk from the Headquarter.

To pay for a one-way ticket on local buses, simply hold your credit card (including virtual credit cards) against the card reader as you board. Please note that this payment method is not available on trains.

Alternatively, use the Skånetrafiken app to buy and activate your ticket beforehand

By car

Axis Headquarters is located directly by the E22 motorway next to the exit "Lund Norra". Take the exit and drive towards Lund city and turn left in the upcoming roundabouts.

Follow the signs and you will find the Axis main building and reception at the end of the street at Gränden 1, Lund.

Parking

Axis offers parking, designated for guests only, directly by the main building. This will allow you to park for free during your visit.

Follow the signs or contact the reception for directions and if you need charging for your electric car.

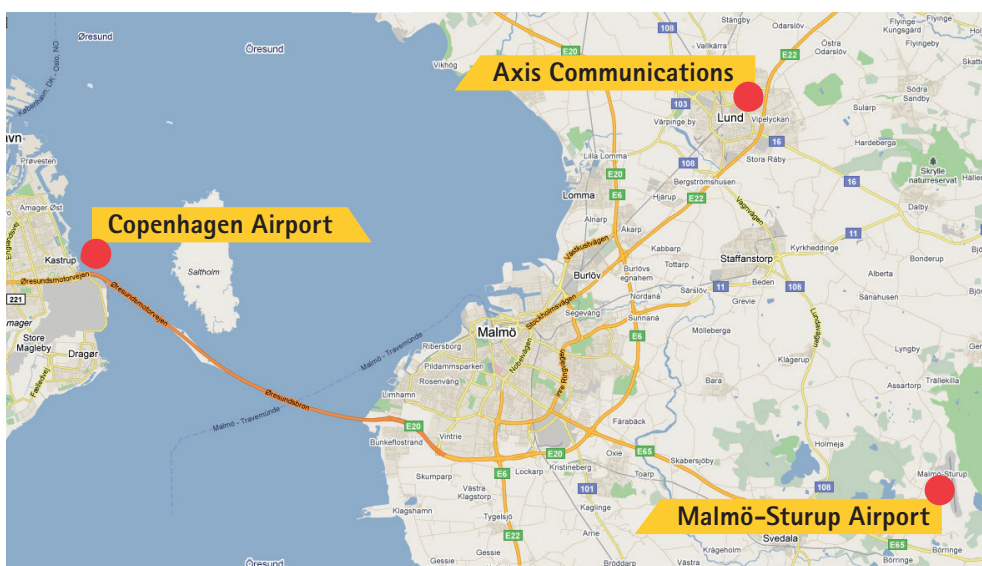

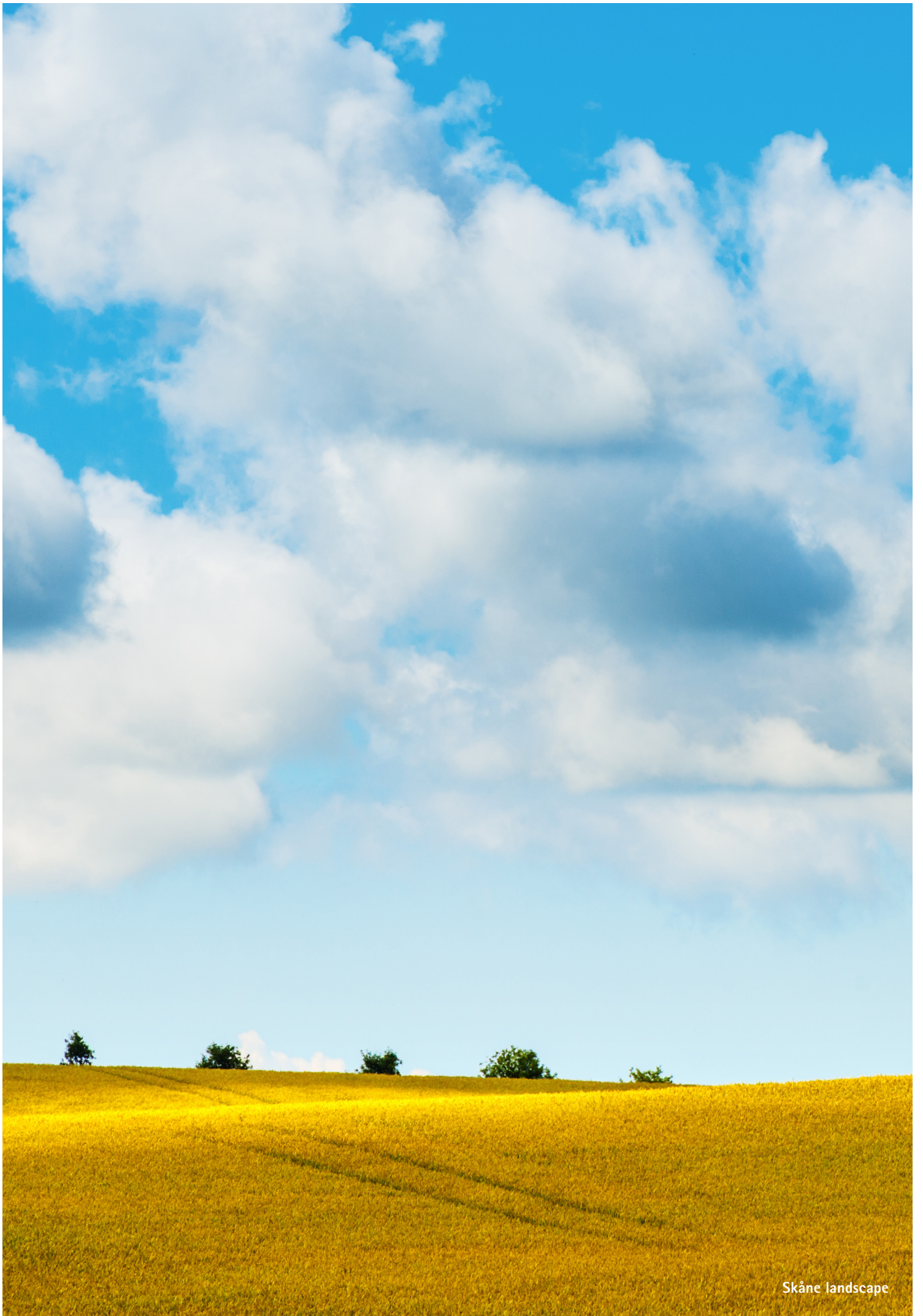

In Sweden, all taxis are licensed and display yellow license plates. The driver should have his/her taxi driver's license visible on the dashboard and rates are clearly visible at the outside of the vehicle to ensure fair rates.

Major credit cards are accepted as payment. To avoid wait times, especially during rush hour, consider prebooking your taxi. If needed, ask the at the Axis reception at Axis Headquarters or your hotel for assistance with booking a taxi.

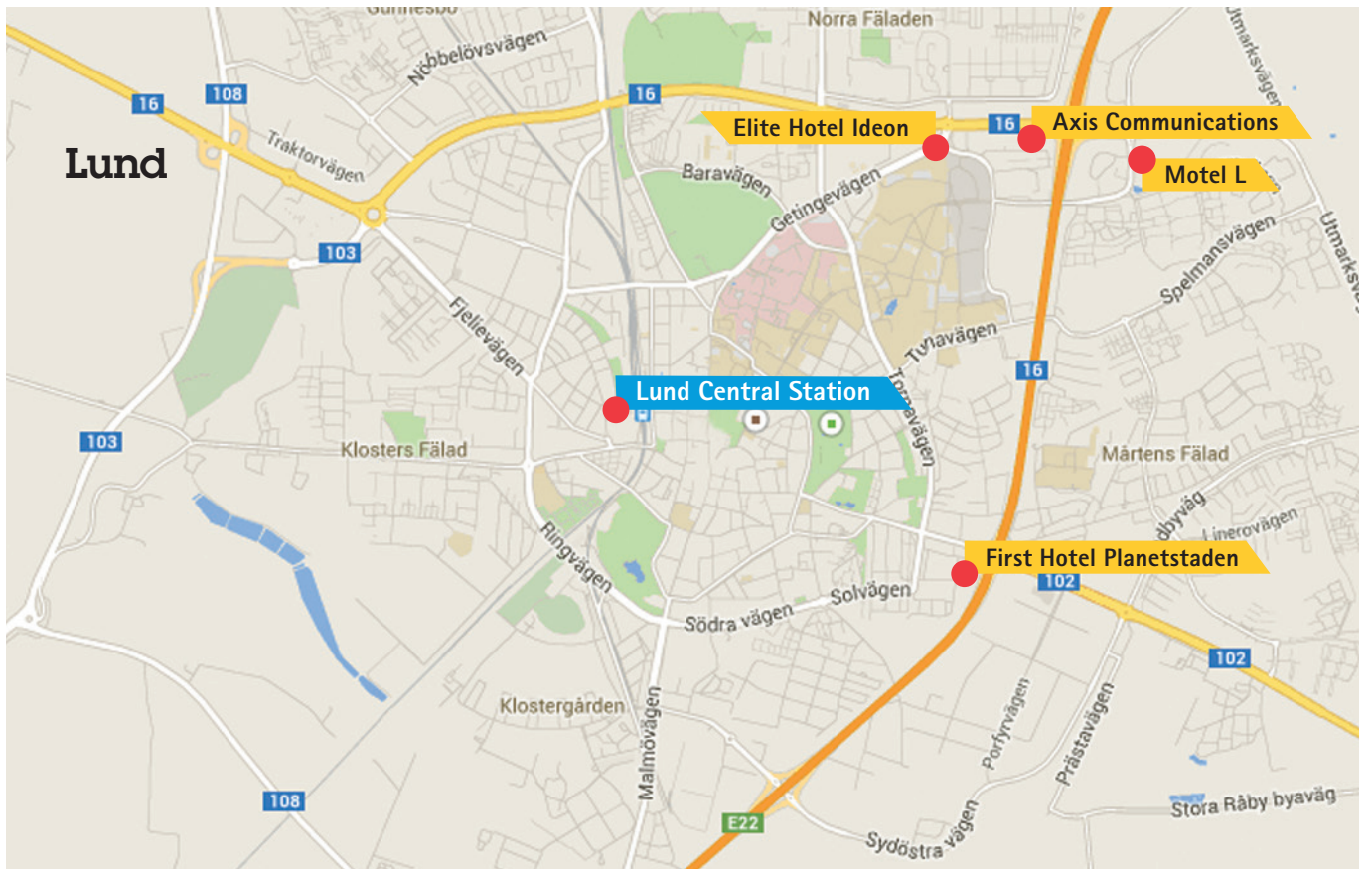

Lund

Lund Cathedral (Lunds Domkyrka)

Over 1,000 years old, Lund Cathedral attracts over 700,000 visitors annually, ranking among Lund's top 10 attractions. Step inside to uncover its rich history and fascinating stories, both within its ancient walls and beyond.

Lund University – main building

Stroll through the Lundagård park, adjacent to the cathedral, and discover the beautiful main building of Lund University. Constructed in 1882, this grand structure draws inspiration from classical Roman and Greek architecture, featuring impressive columns and arches.
